# Reservation of Tennis/Pickleball Courts

For those using these courts through reservation with Stow Recreation Department:

Please note the following rules attendant upon using these sports courts:

- Court use opens April 1<sup>st</sup> and closes November 30<sup>th</sup>, weather permitting. Nets will be up and out.
  - Recreation sponsored/run programs take priority over public reservations. We will do our best to have those dates booked before the April 1<sup>st</sup> opening date. We reserve the right to adjust reservations as needed
  - All reservations need to be made through MyRec, our recreation software, and you'll need to make an account if you don't have one.
  - Reservations will be limited to only 1 month in advance from your first monthly reservation date and for 1.5 hours per day only, either tennis or pickleball use.

We reserve the right to adjust the rules as issues arise, but please be aware we are trying to address issues that arose last summer. We've polled multiple towns around us to see their regulations and modeled ours with a collection of points from those plus what we noted from last year.
